



WELCOME TO THE ALLIANCE HOCKEY OFFICIATING PROGRAM!

Please carefully read the following information and complete your registration today.

Congratulations on being hired by your local referee association! To become eligible to officiate during the 2023-2024 hockey season, you are required to complete the Hockey Canada Officiating Program (HCOP) and ALLIANCE Hockey Officiating Program (AHOP) Entry Level Clinic and meet all screening requirements as outlined below.

2023-2024 HCOP Entry Level Clinic Registration Fees (includes HST)

Officiating Course Requirements	FEES
Hockey Canada HU-Online Officiating 1/2	\$22.00
Entry Level In-Class Clinic (Level 1) – Ages 14 and older as of December 31, 2023	\$110.00

NOTES:

- **Level 1 Officials, 14 years of age or older as December 31, 2023**, are required to complete the HU-Online Officiating Course, attend an Entry Level In-Class Session, and write the Level 1 Exam.
- **REQUESTS FOR REFUNDS**, whether due to payment error or any other reason, will be subject to an administration fee of \$26.00. Refunds will NOT be provided once you have logged into the online recertification course.

- Officials 18 years of age or older who do not have a valid Vulnerable Sector Check (VSS) on file or have an expired VSS, will not be eligible to register or officiate until they have submitted a current Vulnerable Sector Check (VSS) in accordance with the OHF Screening Policy.
